CONSERVATION

In 2025, DALC protected seven remarkable properties across the Driftless landscape, safeguarding grassland bird habitat, trout streams, working farmland, and future Driftless Trail connections.

WINTERGREEN PRESERVE

Acquisition · 245 acres · Lower Wisconsin River near Spring Green

- Now protected, this property near Taliesin overlooks the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway and is planned as a future Driftless Trail gateway and community hub.

PERRY-PRIMROSE BIRD CONSERVATION AREA (BCA)

Acquisition · 83 acres · Near Mount Horeb, WI

- This acquisition safeguards priority grassland bird habitat and is the first addition to the BCA since 2013.

BAILEY EASEMENT

Conservation Easement · 96 acres · Dodgeville, WI

- This undeveloped property conserves diverse ecosystems, protects trout-supporting headwaters, and includes soils of prime agricultural importance.

HILLSIDE PASTURES EASEMENT

Conservation Easement · 77 acres · Near Spring Green, WI

- This property conserves diverse habitats along Lowery Creek, supports Savanna Institute agroforestry research, and secures public access for the Driftless Trail.

RIMROCK (BRISKA) EASEMENT

Conservation Easement · 91 acres · Dodgeville, WI

- This rugged landscape protects rare pine relict forests, diverse oak woodland habitats, and critical trout stream and wetland resources along Cutler Creek.

VAN SICKLEN EASEMENT

Conservation Easement · 306 acres · Dodgeville, WI

- This expansive property protects diverse forest and prairie habitats, high-quality cold-water streams, and significant areas of prime agricultural soil.

ZIMRIN EASEMENT

Conservation Easement · 347 acres · Spring Green, WI

- This landscape conserves diverse Driftless habitats, anchors a critical 2.7-mile Driftless Trail connection, and supports State Threatened wildlife.

CARE

Land doesn't just need protection; it needs stewardship. Volunteers contributed nearly 3,000 hours of stewardship work in 2025, helping restore prairie, remove invasive species, and care for DALC preserves.

BIG ROCK PRESERVE - *Highland*

- Established visitor entry and parking area
- Spot-treated 90 acres for invasive garlic mustard, hedge parsley, and other herbaceous weeds
- Evaluated the site for future management needs

ERICKSON CONSERVATION AREA - *Argyle*

- Burned two units totaling 125 acres
- Cleared 7 acres of invasive shrubs
- Thinned a 1990s-era plantation to transition toward an open swamp white oak savanna

MORRISON PRAIRIE & FOREST PRESERVE - *Muscoda*

- Surveyed for rare wildlife
- Removed trash and old fencelines
- Collected prairie remnant seed to sow in cleared areas

PERRY-PRIMROSE BIRD CONSERVATION AREA - *Mt. Horeb*

- Evaluated the status of prairie remnants
- Treated invasive crown vetch
- Planned for future tree and brush clearing

SARDESON FOREST PRESERVE - *Mineral Point*

- Completed a 9-acre re-entry burn
- Cleared another 2 acres of invasive shrubs
- Worked with volunteers from Cummins Inc. to remove fences and pile brush

WILD OAKS PRESERVE - *New Glarus/Belleville*

- Advanced restoration across 80+ acres of savanna, prairie, and wetland
 - 1,000+ staff and volunteer hours
 - 100 tons of legacy garbage removed
 - Burned over 60 acres
 - Treated 80+ acres for invasive weeds
- Completed construction of a 1-mile loop trail

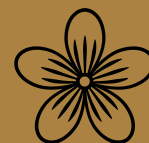

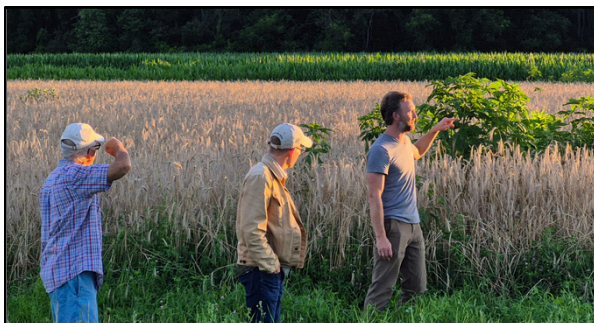

DRIFTLESS TRAIL

- Conducted 16 volunteer work days
 - 10 trail-building days
 - 6 maintenance days
- Engaged 65+ volunteers
 - 478 hours of hands-on trail work contributed
- Completed a 2.6 mile loop at Taliesin's Welsh Hills scheduled to open in 2026
- Welcomed dedicated trail stewards for the Knobs Road, Weaver Road, and Welsh Hills segments
- Completed Phase 1 of Interpretive Planning for the Driftless Trail Project

EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVES

- Provided guidance and assistance on energy efficiency upgrades to the Dodgeville & Mineral Point School Districts
- Secured funding to support educational field trips that connect students to natural areas
- Helped divert more than 11 tons of electronic waste from the landfill through partnering with the Mineral Point Environmental Wellness Club to host an eCycle event

LOWERY CREEK WATERSHED INITIATIVE

- Hosted 6 Evenings Afield programs, drawing 123 attendees to learn about topics like soil health, invasive species, and habitat restoration
- Monitored water quality at 8 sites along Lowery Creek, contributing valuable local data to Wisconsin's statewide Water Action Volunteers database
- Developed a Story Map to share the Lowery Creek watershed's conservation story through the global Community Conservation network, helping connect this work to a broader audience

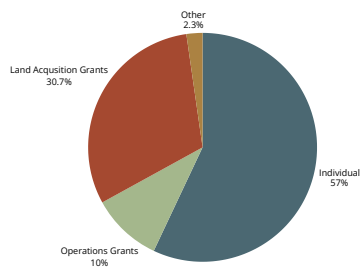

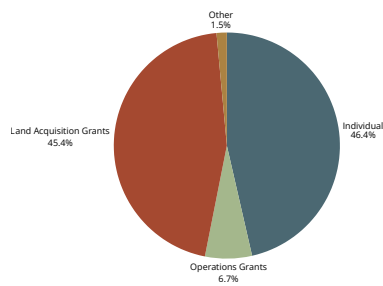

STEWARDSHIP AND ENDOWMENT FUNDS

The **Conservation Easement Stewardship** and **Legal Defense Fund** makes up the “**Forever Fund**”, which consists of donor contributions restricted by the donor or restricted by the Board of Directors. They are managed by Lake Ridge Bank.

- 1: **Conservation Easement Stewardship** provides sustaining funds to ensure that all of our conservation easements are monitored and appropriately stewarded.
- 2: The **Legal Defense Fund** provides sustaining funding to ensure DALC has the resources to defend its interests in land (whether through a conservation easement or ownership) in court.

The **Driftless Conservation Impact Fund** (DCIF) was established in 2022 from a generous donation of land from Helen Boley. Her land is protected forever by a conservation easement. DALC created this fund, restricted by the Board of Directors and managed by Buttonwood Financial Partners, with the proceeds of the sale to a private landowner. The goal of the DCIF is to make catalytic investments in conservation in the Driftless Region, while also providing long-term and sustaining support for DALC conservation work.

The **Driftless Trail Fund** (Trail Fund) was established in 2024 to build and maintain the Driftless Trail. This fund originated from Judy Lovaas' extraordinary bequest. Building and maintaining the Driftless Trail includes activities such as brush clearing and dirt work to build new trails, chainsaw work to open trails after storms, repairing erosion issues, working with and training volunteers, survey work, and hiring contractors and consultants. This fund is invested with Buttonwood Partners.

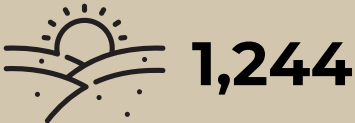
The **Land Management Fund** was established in 2024 with a restricted donation from James and Rose Sime. The purpose of the fund is to provide for ecological land management of DALC nature preserves, including activities such as maintaining current land management plans, surveys, monitoring, prescribed fire, invasive species control, and hiring contractors and consultants. This fund is invested with Buttonwood Partners.
